



Set Up an Odiogo Feed on Your Blog:

A Beginners Tutorial:

What you need first:

1. A free Gmail account
2. A blog on Blogger
3. Some text available to copy and paste into a couple of posts to start your first feeds from Odiogo. I use Gutenberg.org and download a txt. File to paste in a couple of chapters from a book. (See the Turn Gutenberg text to Mp3 tutorial).

What you do:

1. Go to Odiogo (www.odialogo.com) to set up the feed.
2. At the top it will ask you to enter your blog address and your email. Then select "Go!"



3. Odiogo will send out its' web tools to pick up your blog and check that everything is there. It will tell you if you don't have enough content for it to turn into a feed. If you get the screen below - don't worry, just add another post with some text and try submitting again from the screen below. Make sure you have both the blog address and email address in the windows.

4. When it picks up the blog it will say "You are almost done!" and ask you to add their widget to your blog. Click the "Add Odiogo Listen Button Widget" to continue.

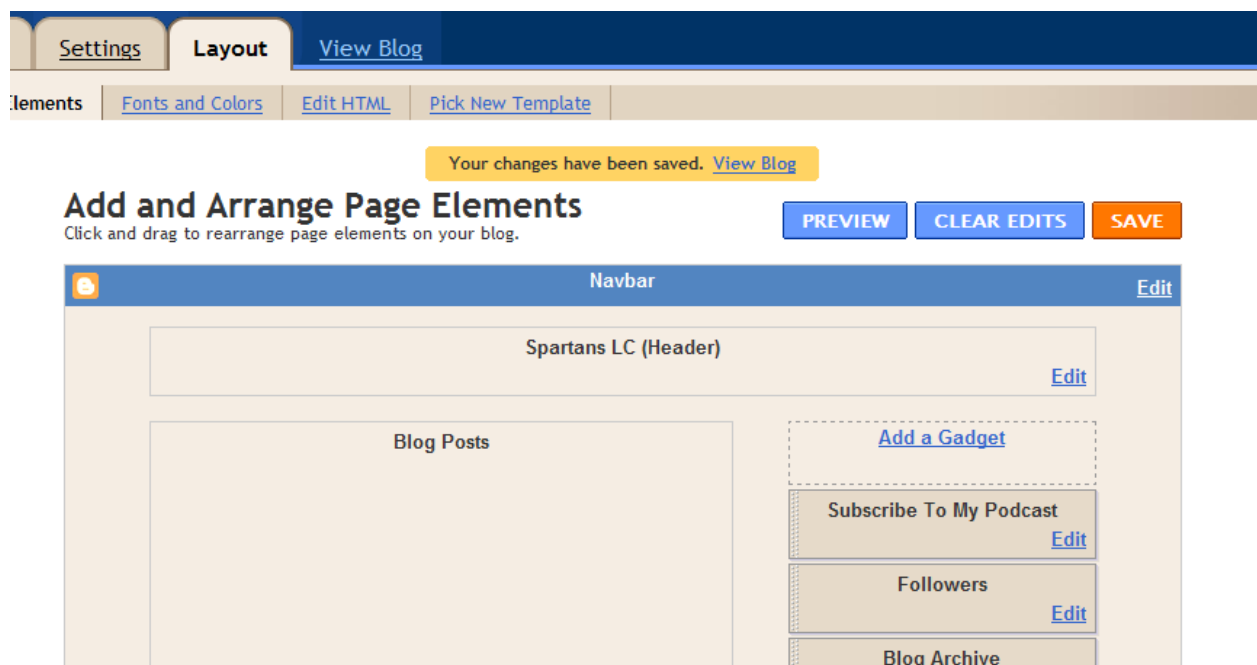
You're almost done! You just need to click the button below and accept the widget on your Blogger blog (Select your blog and click **ADD WIDGET**).

Note: You may need to login to your Blogger account if you're not currently logged on.

5. The next screen will be the add widget screen:



6. When you select "Add Widget", the widget will be added and you will see your Layout tab on your blog where widgets are saved. It will already have been added. All you need to do is select the orange "save" button.



7. When you save and then choose "View blog" at the top, your final product should look something like this:

Now you are ready to start to add text to new posts and listen to them with the Odiogo listen button.

MP3's

The MP3 button allows you to download the feed as a file that can be played on Mp3 players. You just select "MP3" and it will ask you where to save it. Once saved, you can play that in Windows Media Player, transfer to iTunes or on a drag and drop flash drive MP3 player. I use the Pearl 2 GB USB Flash drive MP3 player with headphones. The cost is about \$29.95.

Closing Your Blog

If you want to put your blog behind security so no one can view it then you will also shut out the Odiogo feed from translating your text. I suggest turning off comments if you don't want spam and folks putting things on your blog. I also suggest using the blog as a conversion tool only to convert text to Mp3's and then delete the post. That is up to you. Remember, copyrighted text cannot be put on your blog - that is considered "publishing" when you put text on the web. Unless it is your text, you don't want to do it.
